Chorus then B7 modulate to key of E

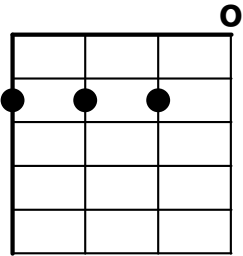
